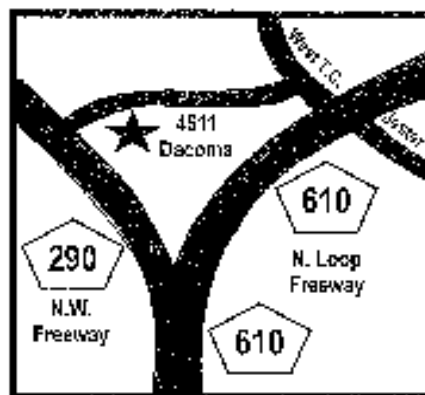

## DIRECTIONS:

### **Going North up 290**

Exit Dacoma/Mangum, stay in far left lane, do u-turn under freeway. Make left at Dacoma. Third building on right (single story brick building behind wrought iron fence).

### **Going South down 290**

Exit Dacoma/Mangum, turn left at Dacoma and go under freeway, third building on right behind wrought iron fence.

### **From Galleria Area—610 North**

Take exit for US-290 W via exit 13B towards Austin. Exit Dacoma/Mangum, stay in far left lane, do u-turn under freeway. Make left at Dacoma, third building on right.

### **From 45—610 West**

Take exit 13C, TC Jester, stay on frontage road, follow it around curve as if you were heading west on 290, turn right on Dacoma, third building on right.

## What is a Trademark?

A **trademark** is a word, a name, symbol, design, color, sound or smell which identifies the source or origin of a good or product in commerce. A **service mark** is a word, name, symbol, design, color, sound or smell which identifies the source or origin of a service in commerce.

### Common Trademark & Service Mark Filings

**Class 09:** Computer software, recordable media, namely, CDs & DVDs

**Class 16:** Printed matter, namely books, manuals, calendars

**Class 25:** Clothing

**Class 35:** Retail store sale and wholesale store services

**Class 41:** Educational services/Entertainment services

**Class 42:** Technical consultation services

### What should I use a ™ or ® ?

™ is a notice, symbol used to designate a "trademark", and indicates that the owner is using the word or design as a trademark in conjunction with the sale or transport of goods in commerce. It is commonly used prior to registration with the United States Patent & Trademark Office. (Similarly, "SM" is a notice symbol used to denote a service mark.) The R in a circle symbol (®) used on goods and services in the United States indicates that the trademark or service mark is registered with the USPTO.

## The Process

*(10 Steps—Takes about 2 Years )*

- Have a bona fide intent to use a mark
- Draft scope of application and get first use dates and first interstate dates
- File one case per class (of the 45) with a specimen
- Receive Office Action from Government
- Respond to Office Action
- Receive Notice of Publication from Government
- Survive Opposition Period
- Obtain registered trademark
- File Section 8 affidavit at 5 years after registration to obtain "incontestability"
- File Renewal fees at 10 years
- Use a watching service or "Google" alerts.

### What is a specimen?

A "real world example" such as a *label, an ad, a photo of a sign, showing how the mark is used in conjunction with the good or service in commerce.*

## Trademarks are:

**ASSETS** to increase company value

**WEAPONS** to help protect market share and keep others from using similar names, to sell similar or related good or service.

**LICENSABLE** Trademarks can be exclusively or non-exclusively licensed for short or long periods of time.

**MARKETING TOOL** to help create brand awareness among customers and competitors.

### How long does a Federal registration last?

*Federal registrations for trademarks or service marks last 10 years, and are renewable from the date of registration.*

### What is an Intent to Use Trademark Application?

*A filing where the owner has a bona fide intention to use the mark in interstate commerce, but has not yet used the mark in commerce as of the filing date of the application.*

### What is an Actual Use Trademark Application?

*A filing where the owner is currently using the mark in commerce as of the filing date of the application.*

### Do I need a watching service?

*Yes, for company names and major branded products.*
